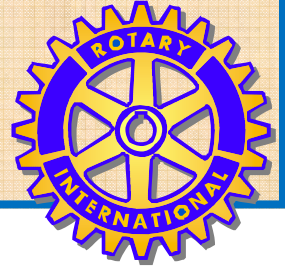

Other subjects include Rob and his quest to find a different venue for the Christmas Party.

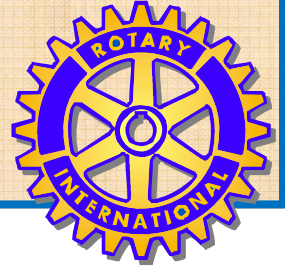
