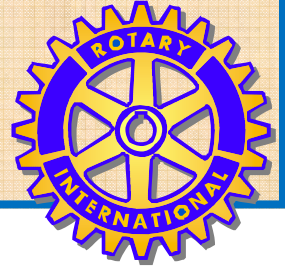

This Weeks Program

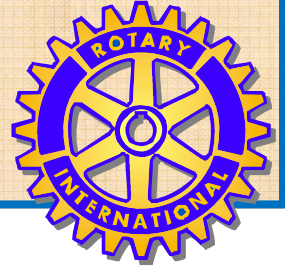
Tim Vincent had program this week and introduced us to his history in the Securities Industry. Tim spent 35 years on Wall Street working for the "Firm", which employs 833,000 people nationwide. The



"Firm" is just securities trading and not banking. He has worked for both the NYSE and NASDAQ. While New York trades stock, bonds, Chicago is strictly commodities. It is the traders who set the price for commodities. Back in New York, only 10% of all trading is stock and the remainder is bonds. 90% of trading transactions are facilitated via technology while the floor handles a small percentage of trading. The Wall Street floor is not so important anymore.

Don't forget to vote for Tim Vincent's joke of the month.

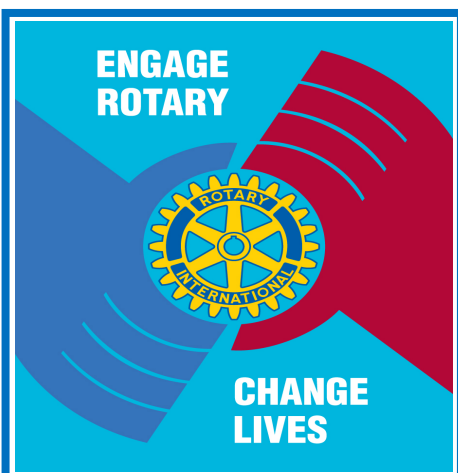
Sue has created press releases for the Holiday Decorating contest for the residents and the business owners. Judging will take place Sunday the 22nd.
